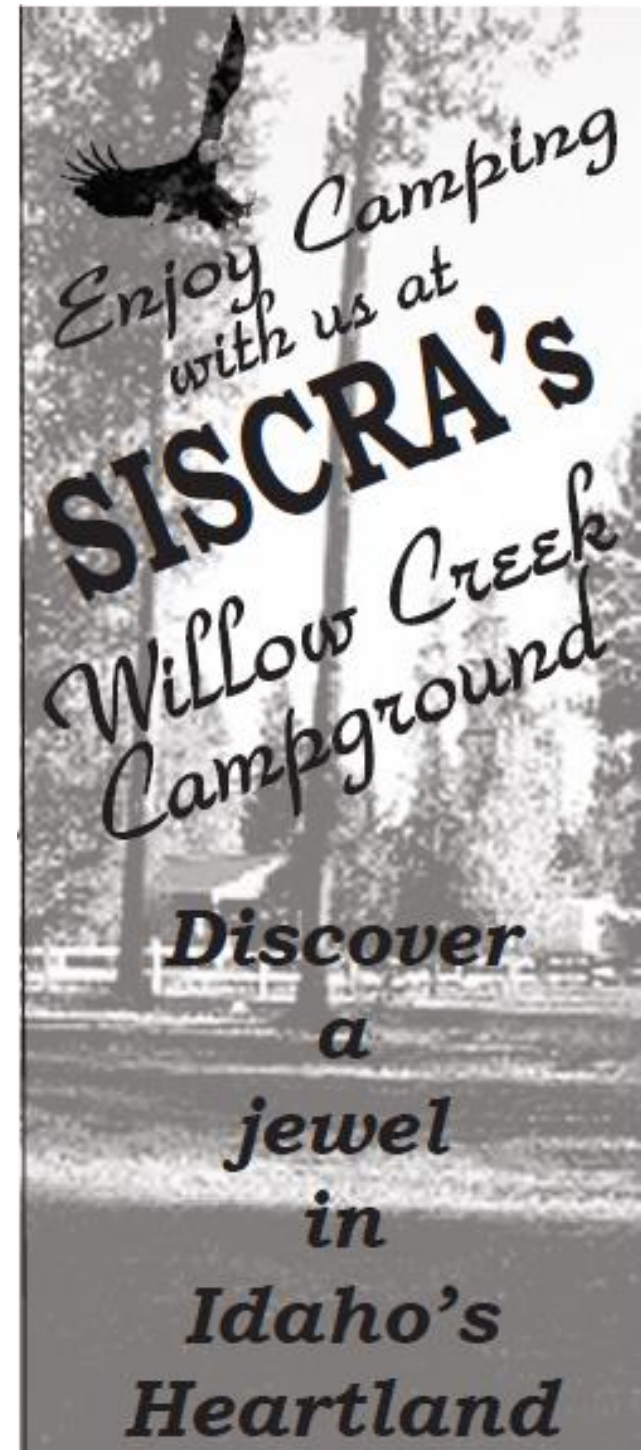
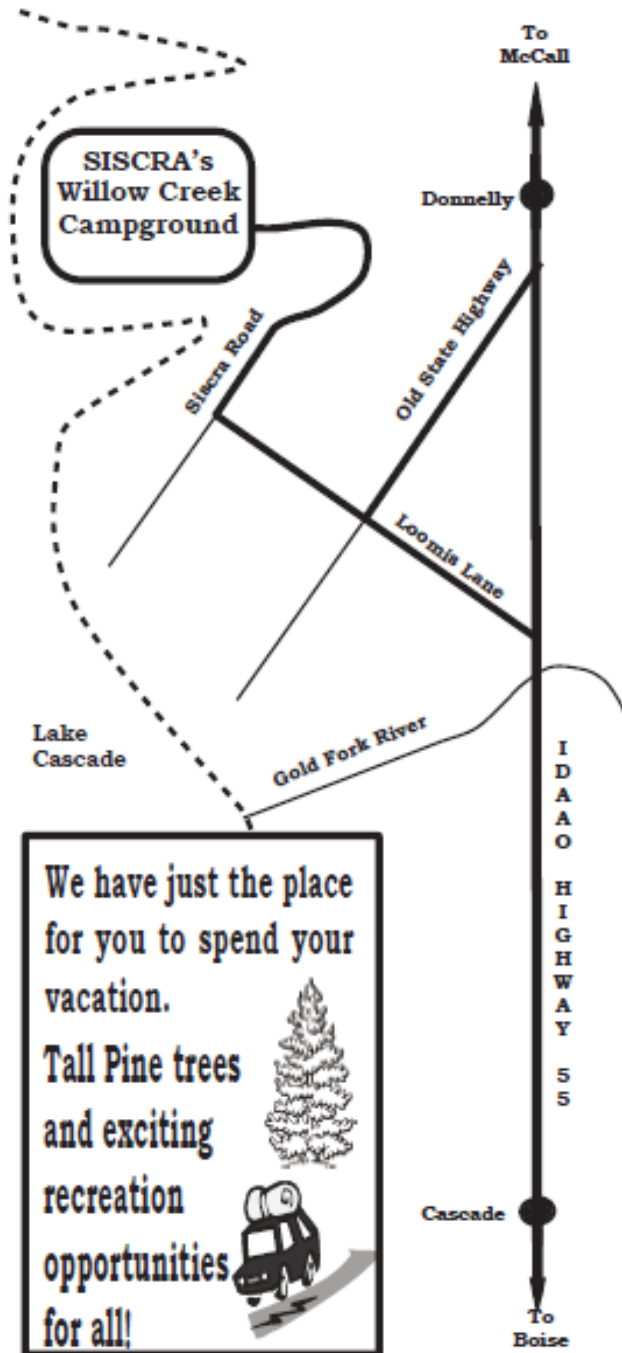

Willow Creek Campground Rules

Revised November 2018

The Directors of SISCRA have set the following rules for your comfort and protection. Anyone not complying with the rules may be asked to leave the campground.

1. **CHECK OUT TIME** is 1:00 P. M. Please plan to depart by that time.
2. **QUIET TIME:** Between the hours of 10:00 P. M. and 7:00 A. M.
No generators, music, radios, loud talking or noise during this time.
3. **SITE RESERVATIONS** are not allowed except for the group area. "First Come First Serve" is the rule. Only one (1) campsite per person may be rented. You may not rent another site for a friend or relative. **NO SUB-RENTING OF SITES.**
4. **CAMPSITE BOUNDARIES** are marked by logs or natural boundaries. All tents, vehicles, boats or personal items must be placed within these boundaries. Do not use an empty adjacent site to store any items or vehicles. Additional offsite storage areas are available for your use if needed. Check with the gatekeeper for storage areas. **Please keep the beauty of your campsite un-cluttered.**
5. **MAXIMUM SITE CAPACITY** is one (1) family or party of no more than eight (8) persons. Only three (3) structures are permitted on any one (1) site. The structures may be a combination, such as: one (1) RV, one (1) screened shelter and one (1) tent; OR one (1) RV and two (2) tents; OR two (2) tents and one (1) gazebo; etc. An RV is defined as a motor home, a truck/camper, or trailer towed by another vehicle. No more than one (1) RV will be permitted on a site at any given time. **Laundry lines for swimsuits and towels only.**
6. **CAMPGROUND WATER SUPPLY** must be shared. Only connect a hose to faucet to fill your RV fresh water tank when needed. Never leave hoses attached. **Washing RV's or vehicles is prohibited.**
7. **OPERATORS OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLES** including ATV's, motorcycles, dune buggies, etc. must have a valid driver's license. Riding in the campground is only permitted from site to site, to campground activities or out to the point.
8. **PETS** are welcome but you are required to:
 - A. Keep pets on a 6 foot leash, in your RV, or in a secure pen at all times. If you are anywhere in the park, pets must be under your control. **HAVING A PET HERE IS A PRIVILEGE – NOT A RIGHT.**
 - B. **IMMEDIATELY PICK UP AFTER YOUR PET'S** mess and deposit in a dumpster.
 - C. Number of pets is limited to a reasonable number that can be controlled by their owners so as not to become a nuisance to other guests. Keep your dogs from barking as much as possible.
 - D. SISCRA reserves the right to ask that the owners of uncontrolled dogs leave the campground.
9. **CAMPFIRES** are allowed only in designated fire pits. Fire rings may not be moved or added unless they are approved by a director. Please extinguish all fires before retiring to your RV or leaving the fire ring.
10. **CAMPGROUND SPEED LIMIT** is 5 miles per hour while in the park. Please obey at all times. **Children at Play.**
11. **GARBAGE** must be placed in a dumpster or other designated trash container. Aluminum cans should be placed in the white plastic containers which is provided. They will be recycled.
12. **CHILD SUPERVISION** - You must supervise all children under your care while in the campground. We ask that they do not play in any building unless with adult supervision. You will be required to pay for any damages that they cause.
13. **CAMPGROUND OWNED EQUIPMENT** may be operated only if prior approval is obtained from a SISCRA board Director. Anyone using campground equipment will do so at their own risk. No one is allowed to use a chain saw without another person being present.
14. **NATIVE TREES OR PLANTS** may not be removed without permission. Contact the office for approval or assistance when necessary.
15. **GUNS AND FIREWORKS:** The discharge of firearms or use of fireworks are prohibited at all times.
16. **SMOKING** is only allowed in your RV site, RV or vehicle, or if there is a 3 foot clearance on each side of you. Smoking is permitted in compliance with Forest Service Regulations during a NO FIRE BAN. You may be asked to leave the campground if you do not dispose of cigarette butts properly.
17. **ROADS** are designated as either one way or two way. Please obey the traffic flow restrictions as shown by the arrows on the map and the "Do Not Enter" signs on the one way roads.
18. **MESSAGES** - Only emergency messages will be delivered immediately. Others will be delivered between 9:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M. You may ask to use the telephone only if an emergency exists.
19. **FISH CLEANING** in restrooms and buildings is prohibited. Please dispose of all fish cleaning waste off site or sealed within two (2) plastic bags before placing it in the campground dumpsters.

SISCRA and Bureau of Reclamation

Willow Creek Campground is located on land provided by the Bureau of Reclamation. The campground is managed by SISCRA for the use of its members and the general public. It is open to anyone wishing to stay in the campground.
